

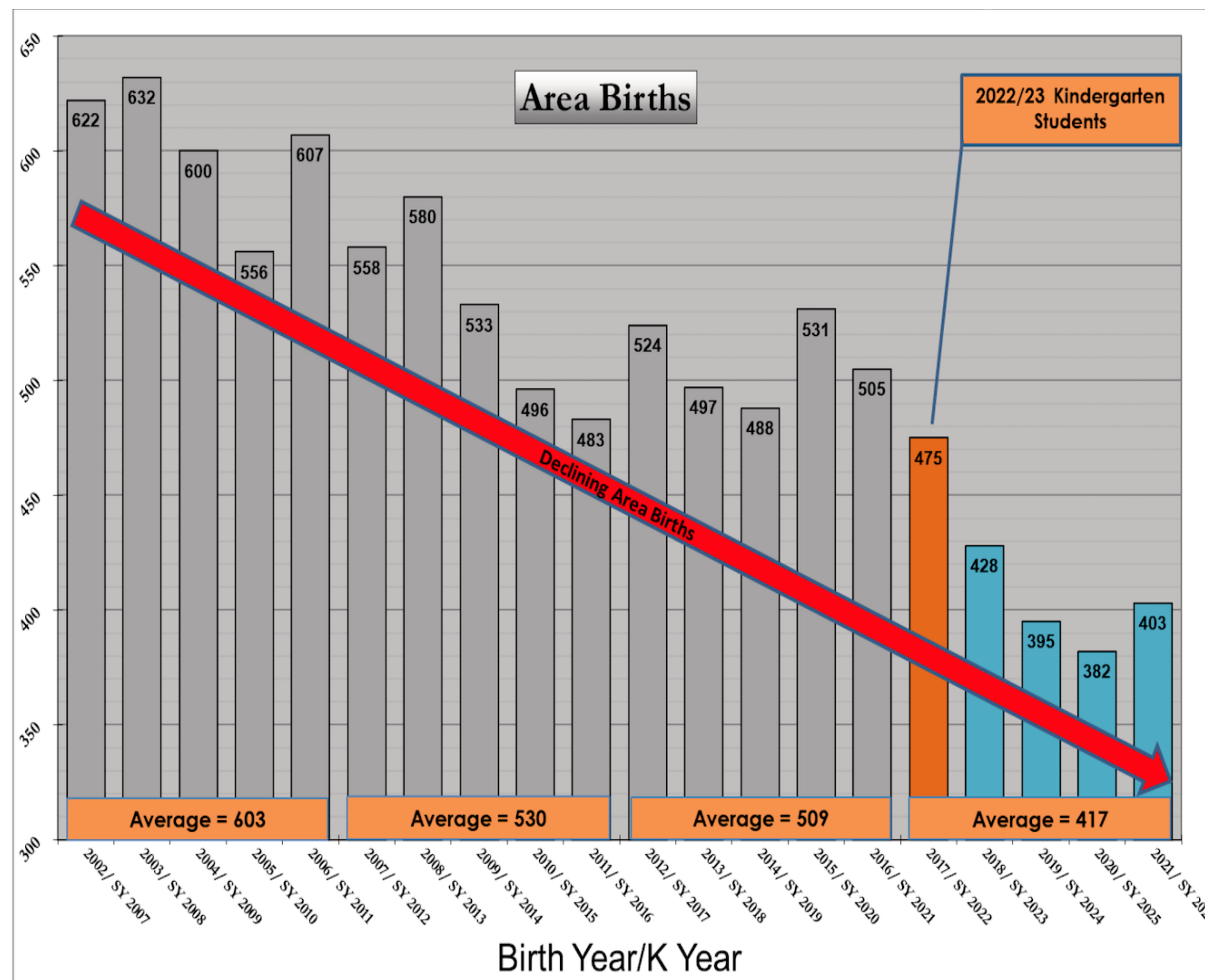
# PUBLIC SCHOOL STABILITY

## ENHANCE PUBLIC SCHOOL STABILITY

- **Mitigate Declining Enrollment:**
  - VFD is projected to add 701 students over the next 15 years
- **Reduce Interdistrict Transfers:**
  - Currently 1,307 students are commuting into Davis
  - Declining resident enrollment requires more commuting students
- **Homes Priced and Designed to Enable:**
  - Teachers & Staff to afford to live in Davis
  - Families to move back & stay in Davis

- **Early Learning Pre-K School** with sliding scale day care
